All Advanced Providers must submit current
Copies of their EMT & CPR card, and Provider Agreement.

- 10 Hours of Classroom Time per Year. (50% ILS/ALS)
- 3 Field or 1 Classroom IV
- 1 Field or 1 Classroom Adult Intubations
- 1 Classroom Adult Intraosseous
- 1 Classroom EJV
- 1 Classroom Double lumen

AEMT-CRITICAL CARE TECHNICIAN:

- 20 Hours of Classroom Time per Year. (50% ALS)
- 3 Field or 1 Classroom IV
- 1 Field or 1 Classroom Adult Intubation
- 1 Classroom Child Intubation
- 1 Classroom Chest Decompression
- 1 Classroom EJV
- 1 Classroom Defibrillation
- 1 Classroom External Cardiac Pacing
- 1 Classroom Intraosseous
- 1 Classroom Double lumen
- 1 Classroom Quick Trach

PARAMEDIC:

- 24 Hours of Classroom Time per Year. (50% ALS)
- 3 Field or 1 Classroom IV

CME REQUIREMENTS EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2009

All ALS Providers in the Midstate EMS Region, must complete a series of skill requirements, two times a year. The first reporting period (First Semester) begins January 1st of each year, and ends June 30th of each year. The Second Semester begins on July 1st and ends on December 31st. The skill requirements for each level are listed on page four of this booklet.

All ALS Providers, in the Midstate EMS Region, must also complete didactic, or classroom time two times each year. The first semester 50% of your required didactic hours are due. The end of the semester the remaining 50% of your required didactic hours are due. The time can be submitted any time during the first or second semester. The required didactic hours are listed on the opposite page. Remember, at least 50% of the required hours must be ALS.

If you are a new provider or changing levels within the region you will need to contact this office prior to practicing at the level you are certified. If you have taken a refresher course, you will need to submit a copy of your current card to this office. The course sponsors who put the courses on only receive scores for each student. They DO NOT get copies of the EMT cards. It is the provider's responsibility to send a current copy of their EMT card to the Program Agency.

Once the Program Agency has a current copy of your EMT/CPR cards (front and back), a Provider Agreement, you will be issued a secured Photo-Id which grants you privileges to practice at the level outlined on the front of the Photo-Id. If the necessary documentation is not on file, you will be suspended and privileges revoked.
