

**POLICY: NOTIFICATION OF STABLE BLS PATIENTS**  
**AUTHORIZED BY: MIDSTATE REMAC 12/11/01**  
**MIDSTATE REMSCO**  
**EFFECTIVE: JAN 1, 2002**

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**Hospital notification of STABLE BLS patients will be via Resource Hospital. These reports should be given as early as possible. The information will be transferred to the receiving hospital, by the Resource Operator. STABLE BLS patient reports to Resource should include only the following information:**

- ◆ Agency
- ◆ EMT
- ◆ Hospital Requested
- ◆ Age
- ◆ Sex
- ◆ Chief Complaint
- ◆ ETA

**DO NOT USE ABBREVIATED REPORTS FOR THESE PATIENTS**

- 1) Patients that meet NYS DOH Trauma Criteria
- 2) Potential Overdose / Poisoning Patients
- 3) Patients meeting ALS criteria refusing prehospital ALS care
- 4) Labor and Delivery Patients

**These patient reports should be given directly to the receiving hospital, via Resource**

**THIS REPORTING SYSTEM IS FOR NOTIFICATION ONLY, NOT FOR MEDICAL DIRECTION. WHEN AN EMT REQUESTS MEDICAL DIRECTION, THAT MEDICAL CONTROL WILL COME FROM THE RECEIVING HOSPITAL.**
